

BACK for GOOD

Important

Note: BACK for GOOD is not a cleaner.

BACK for GOOD is a crystal clear coating

Any dirt left on the trim will be seen through the coating and block the coating from rejuvenating the plastic leaving a patchy or cloudy result.

Instructions

- 1 Wash the trim with mild soapy water removing **ALL** previous coatings, grease and silicones. It is advised that a soft scrubbing brush is used to clean the textured areas.
- 2 Rinse down the area well, ensuring that all soap is removed. A good test is to look at the trim when it is wet. If it looks good with no blemishes, then this is how it will look when coated. If not then repeat step 1 until all contamination and oxidization is removed.
- 3 Allow to dry **completely**.
- 4 Coat a small test area as directed in step 5 first
- 5 Apply BACK for GOOD with a **lint free cloth only**. Dampen the cloth with the coating. It is sometimes easier if you pour a small amount into a tray.
Wipe the coating onto the trim and into the texture. Once the coating starts to dry DO NOT continue to wipe. If you have missed a small area wait until completely dry then apply a second coat. Drying time is usually 5 to 15 minutes depending on temperature. You may speed up the drying time by **gentle** use of a blower or hairdryer in cold conditions.

The coating will take 24 hours to cure (harden fully) Although when dry it is ok to use your vehicle usually an hour or so is good.

Made a MISTAKE ?

If your end result is patchy or cloudy this means you did not fully remove all of the previous silicone, oils or dirt so please follow the following instructions.

If you make a mistake or you are not completely satisfied with the results, maybe you didn't fully clean the surface and you can still see dirt under the coating etc. You can easily remove the coating and start again by using **de-natured alcohol or mentholated spirits**. Simply wipe over the area with a cloth soaked in **de-natured alcohol or mentholated spirits** removing the coating. Re-clean, dry and re-coat
